



General Terms and Conditions for the CIRSE 2010 Registration

1. Scope of Application

1.1 These General Terms and Conditions exclusively stipulate the regulations for the Registration for CIRSE 2010 in Valencia.

1.2 A contractual relationship subject to these terms and conditions is entered into between the CIRSE Congress Research Education GmbH (hereinafter referred to as "CIRSE GmbH") with its registered office in 1010 Vienna, Neutorgasse 9, and the participant of CIRSE 2010 (hereinafter referred to as "participant").

1.3 Any contractual or legal declarations of the participant deviating from these general terms and conditions shall not be part of the contract entered into with CIRSE GmbH notwithstanding the consumption of the services offered by CIRSE by the participant and the payment of fees therefore.

2. Registration

2.1 Registration for the CIRSE 2010 is to be made electronically by completing the respective registration forms provided on the homepage of CIRSE GmbH (www.cirse.org). Registration forms submitted without full name, complete email and postal address and/or date of birth cannot not be processed.

2.2 Upon registration the participant shall receive an electronic confirmation about the registration for verification of the participant's personal data only.

2.3 The participant's registration for CIRSE 2010 shall not become effective prior to CIRSE GmbH having received the full registration fee due.

2.4 Payment of the registration fee can be effected either by bank transfer or by credit card (VISA or MasterCard/EuroCard).

2.5 Upon payment of the registration fee by credit card the participant will receive a confirmation email. The invoice for the registration fee is available on the homepage of the CIRSE GmbH in a secure area. To access this area a USERiD and Password provided to the participant electronically, is required.

2.6 In case payment of the registration fee by bank transfer is the chosen payment method the recipient will receive a confirmation of registration by email upon completion of registration. Both the relevant confirmation of order as well as the invoice for the registration fee is available on the homepage of the CIRSE GmbH in a secure area. To access this area a USERiD and Password, provided to the participant electronically, is required.

2.7 Payment by cheque is not accepted.

2.8 Cancellation

CIRSE offers all participants the possibility of taking out cancellation insurance with our partner, "Europäische Reiseversicherung" (see www.cirse.org). CIRSE will not provide refunds after a cancellation of registration. All requests for refund have to be issued to the "Europäische Reiseversicherung".

2.9 Name changes

Name changes will be handled like the cancellation of one registration and the registration of another participant.

3. Registration Fees

3.1 Registration fees shall be subject to the date of registration, the date of payment of the registration fee and the registration category.

3.2 The following registration fees and deadlines shall be valid for CIRSE 2010.

3.3 The respective registration fees shall only be valid if registration is submitted and full payment is received by CIRSE GmbH by the respective deadline. A failure to meet the relevant deadline will render the relevant invoice invalid, no congress badge will be provided and no confirmation of payment will be issued.

3.4 Reduced registration fees for CIRSE 2010 are only available for those members who have been in good standing with CIRSE in 2009 and 2010.
(Individuals who become CIRSE members 2010 will be able to benefit from reduced congress fees starting at CIRSE 2011).

3.5 Registrations categorised as Resident/Technician/Nurse/Student must be followed by a confirmation of a participant's head of department, submitted to CIRSE GmbH within five days after the participant's registration has been submitted. A failure to provide confirmation of the registration category in due time will result in re-categorisation of the participant's registration as Non-Member registration that will be charged accordingly.

4. Badges and Safety

The safety of all congress delegates and participants is of utmost importance to the CIRSE GmbH. Security measures and precautions at the CIRSE 2010 venue have been tightened to ensure maximum security for all attendees. Badges must be worn visibly on the congress grounds at all times. The CIRSE GmbH reserves the right for staff to check participants' identification upon admission to and/or inside the congress venue. Participants may at any time be requested to present adequate proof of identity, in the form of a passport, driver's license, national or military identification or student ID. Documents for the proof of identity must include a photograph and signature.



5. Congress Material

The congress material (badges, etc.) will either be sent to the participant in advance or will be made available to the participant on-site at the relevant terminals marked with "Registration", on October 2, 2010, from 7 am to 6 pm.

6. Certificate of Attendance/CME Accreditation

Any confirmation or certification related to the CIRSE 2010 will be available during and after the congress on the CIRSE website, at www.cirse.org. The Lastname and CIRSEiD will be required to access the personalised congress related documents online.

7. Limitation of Liability

7.1 CIRSE GmbH's liability and obligations in the case of cancellation of CIRSE 2010 for what reasons ever shall be limited to the reimbursement of registration fees only.

7.2 Apart from damages caused by physical injury CIRSE GmbH's liability for any other damages of what kind ever shall be restricted to wilful intent or gross negligence.

7.3 CIRSE GmbH shall not be liable for any damages caused by force majeure.

8. Personal Data

The participants consent that their personal data including their email address submitted with the registration for CIRSE 2010 is put at the disposal of the exhibitors' listed for the purpose of providing the participants with marketing and information material relating to the field of Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiology. CIRSE GmbH shall not be liable for any damages or claims (art.8) caused by exhibitors or service providers who may perform certain services or functions on behalf of exhibitors.

The participants acknowledge that this consent can be withdrawn any time without giving reason.

9. Photo Policy

Recording, Photographing, Interviewing Not Allowed

No attendee at the CIRSE annual meeting may record, film, tape, photograph, interview, or use any other such media during any presentation, display, or exhibit without the express, advance



written approval of the CIRSE Central Office. This policy applies to all CIRSE members, non-members, guests, and exhibitors, as well as members of the print, online, or broadcast media. (See also Media Policy.)

10. Media Policy

The Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe (CIRSE), a non-profit professional society, welcomes media representatives to its annual meetings to report objectively on scientific presentations and environmental issues. Registration is complimentary for editorial staff representatives of general circulation newspapers and magazines, and scientific publications. All media representatives of the CIRSE annual meeting must formally register in prior to the meeting with an e-mail to registration@cirse.org.

In order to prevent disruptions and to ensure science-based discourse among speakers and attendees, the following policy applies:

- There will be no cameras allowed in, nor radio broadcasts made directly from, technical sessions without the express, advance written approval of the CIRSE Central Office. Filming may be allowed in Poster Sessions (only after having received permission from poster author), in the Press Room with consenting speakers, in the Plenary Sessions, and in the Exhibition Hall, after having received written permission from the CIRSE Central Office.
- No audio taping for re-broadcast of technical presentations or question-and-answer sessions is allowed without express, advance written approval by the CIRSE Central Office.
- All requests for filming, photographs, interviews, etc. outside this policy must be submitted to the CIRSE Central Office for a decision.
- This policy is intended to engender a rational and professional forum in which science-based issues can be discussed. Any media representative who sells, markets, or represents a company for purposes of obtaining advertising or subscriptions from any exhibitor or registrant will immediately forfeit press credentials for this and subsequent meetings.

11. Photo/Film Release

Photographs and films will be taken at the Annual Meeting. By registering for this meeting, you agree to allow CIRSE to use your photo and film in any CIRSE-related publication or website.



12. Applicable Law/Place of Venue

12.1 Any contractual relationship with CIRSE GmbH shall be subject to Austrian law with the exception of the Vienna Convention on the International Sale of Goods (UNCITRAL). As far as consumers are concerned, such choice of law shall be applied only insofar as the granted protection is not deprived due to obligatory provisions of the country where the consumer has his or her habitual abode.

12.2 The place of venue fulfillment and jurisdiction shall be 1010 Vienna. CIRSE GmbH shall be entitled to pursue any claim before the courts of law competent for the defendant's domicile or general residence. In cases where the participant is a consumer such legal venue shall only be deemed to apply, if the participant has his or her residence, habitual abode or place of employment in said court district or if the participant does not reside in Austria.

13.3. Should any provision of this General Terms and Conditions for the CIRSE 2010 Registration concluded with the participant be or become entirely or partially ineffective, this shall not affect the effectiveness or enforceability of the remaining provisions. The provision that has become entirely or partially ineffective shall be replaced with a new provision, the contents, meaning and purpose of which conform as far as possible economically and legally to those of the ineffective provision.
