

General Terms and Conditions for the ECIO 2021 registration and participation

1. Scope of Application

1.1 These General Terms and Conditions exclusively govern the registration for and participation in ECIO 2021.

1.2 A contractual relationship governed by these terms and conditions is entered into between CIRSE Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe (hereinafter referred to as "CIRSE Society") with its registered office in 1010 Vienna, Neutorgasse 9, and the participant of ECIO 2021 (hereinafter referred to as "the participant").

1.3 Any contractual or legal declarations of the participant deviating from these general terms and conditions shall not be part of the contract between CIRSE Society and the participant.

2. Registration

2.1 Registration for ECIO 2021 has to be made electronically by completion of the respective registration form provided on the official CIRSE website (www.cirse.org) or ECIO website (www.ecio.org). Registration forms submitted without full name, complete e-mail and postal address and/or date of birth cannot be processed.

2.2 Upon electronic submission of the completed registration form, the participant shall receive an electronic confirmation for the purpose of verification of the participant's personal data only. The contract between CIRSE Society and the participant shall be deemed concluded upon confirmation of receipt of the registration form by CIRSE Society.

2.3 The participant's registration for ECIO 2021 shall only become effective upon the receipt of full payment of the registration fee by CIRSE Society, i.e. only those participants having fully paid their registration fees will be entitled to participate in ECIO 2021.

2.4 Payment of the registration fee can be effected either by bank transfer or by credit card (VISA or MasterCard).

2.5 Upon payment of the registration fee (either by credit card or bank transfer), the participant will receive a confirmation that his registration is complete and effective by e-mail. He will further receive a USER ID and password enabling the participant to access a secure area on the CIRSE website where he can retrieve the invoice for the registration fee as well as the confirmation of effective registration.

The recipient's name and order number must be provided as a reference on the bank transfer document. Any bank charges incurred are to be paid by the participant.

2.6 Payment by cheque is not accepted.

2.7 Cancellation of the registration by the participant

In case the participant cancels his registration or changes the registration category, CIRSE Society will not refund any registration fees except in the case of section 2.8 below.

2.8 Special Withdrawal Right for Consumers being EU residents

A participant being a consumer residing in a Member State of the EU has the right to withdraw from this contract within 14 days without giving any reason.

The withdrawal period will expire after 14 days from the day of the conclusion of the contract

To exercise the right of withdrawal, the participant must inform CIRSE Society (CIRSE Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe, Neutorgasse 9, 1010 Vienna, Austria; Phone: +43 1 904 2003; Fax: + 43 1 904 2003 30; E-mail: registration@cirse.org) of his/her decision to withdraw from this contract by an unequivocal statement (e.g. a letter sent by post, fax or e-mail). The Participant may use the attached model withdrawal form, which is not obligatory. In case of withdrawal, CIRSE Society will communicate to the participant an acknowledgement of receipt of such a withdrawal by e-mail within two days.

To meet the withdrawal deadline, it is sufficient that the Participant sends a communication concerning the exercise of the right of withdrawal before the withdrawal period has expired.

Effects of withdrawal:

If the Participant withdraws from this contract, CIRSE Society shall reimburse all payments received from the Participant, without undue delay and in any event not later than 14 days from the day on which CIRSE Society is informed about the Participant's decision to withdraw from this contract. CIRSE Society will carry out such reimbursement using the same means of payment as the Participant used for the initial transaction, unless the Participant has expressly agreed otherwise; in any event, the Participant will not incur any fees as a result of such reimbursement.

If the Participant requested to begin the performance of services during the withdrawal period, then the Participant shall pay CIRSE Society an amount which is in proportion to what has been provided until the Participant has communicated to CIRSE Society his/her withdrawal from this contract, in comparison with the full coverage of the contract.

I acknowledge that once CIRSE starts to fulfil the contract, I lose my right of withdrawal.

2.9 Cancellation of ECIO 2021

CIRSE Society has the right to revise dates of ECIO 2021, as well as to shorten the time of ECIO 2021 if it considers such amendments as appropriate, in particular due to changed circumstances or other factual changes which could not be expected at the time the registration period for the congress started. Any change in the length or time does not entitle the registered participants to request refund or lowering of fees nor to put forward a claim to damages incurred thereby.

In case of cancellation of ECIO 2021 for whatever reasons, CIRSE Society will refund to the participant the registration fee less such costs already accrued until the date of cancellation.

2.10 Name changes

Name changes will be handled like the cancellation of one registration and the registration of another participant.

3. Registration Fees

3.1 Registration fees differ depending on the date of registration, the date of payment of the registration fee and the registration category.

*** Undergraduate medical student registrations must be accompanied by this completed Student Confirmation Form, a copy of a valid photo ID and a one-page CV in English. Please be advised that CIRSE will not provide any documents for visa purposes. CIRSE Student members do not need to upload any documentation and can benefit from the fast-track registration.*

**** The Technology Innovation Only registration includes access to a new form of virtual industry exhibition, satellite symposia and the technology innovation channel content, as well as the product category search tool on the ECIO platform. Please note that this ticket does not include the live and on demand CME conference programme.*

3.3 The respective registration fees shall only be valid if registration is submitted and full payment is received by CIRSE Society by the respective deadline. If payment of the registration fee is received later than the respective deadline for early registration, the respective next higher fee shall be due. If no payment is received by the last deadline, no access will be granted and the participant will not be entitled to take part in ECIO 2021.

3.4 Reduced CIRSE Member Registration is only available for members of CIRSE (Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe) in good standing.

4. Group registrations and other registrations for third parties

4.1 Group registrations, whereby a person or company ("group leader") carries out registration for and on behalf of third parties, are possible if the group consists of a minimum of 1 person. The group leader herewith declares that he acts for and on behalf of the third parties as mentioned in the registration and that all third parties have agreed to such representation. Upon completion of the registration, the contractual relationship is deemed to be concluded between CIRSE Society and the respective participant. The group leader shall be liable for any and all damages resulting from the violation of his obligations.

5. Certificate of Attendance

Any confirmation related to the ECIO 2021 will be available during and after the congress on the CIRSE website at www.cirse.org or on the ECIO website at www.ecio.org. Your personal log-in details will be required to access the personalised congress related documents online.

6. Limitation of Liability

6.1 CIRSE Society shall not be liable for any loss or damage which is suffered by the participant save in respect of such loss or damage which is suffered as a result of wilful misconduct or gross negligence by CIRSE Society.

6.2 CIRSE Society shall not be liable for any loss or damage which is suffered by the participant as a result of force majeure.

6.3 CIRSE Society shall not be liable for any damages or claims caused by exhibitors or service providers who may perform certain services or functions on behalf of exhibitors.

7. Data Protection

8. Applicable Law/Place of Venue

8.1 Any contractual relationship with CIRSE Society shall be subject to Austrian law with the exception of the Vienna Convention on the International Sale of Goods (UNCITRAL). As far as consumers are concerned, such choice of law shall be applied only insofar as the granted protection is not deprived due to obligatory provisions of the country where the consumer has his or her habitual abode.

8.2 The place of venue, fulfilment and jurisdiction shall be 1010 Vienna. CIRSE Society shall be entitled to pursue any claim before the courts of law competent for the defendant's domicile or general residence. In cases where the participant is a consumer such legal venue shall only be deemed to apply, if the participant has his or her residence, habitual abode or place of employment in said court district or if the participant does not reside in Austria.

8.3. Should any provision of this General Terms and Conditions for the ECIO 2021 Registration concluded with the participant be or become entirely or partially ineffective, this shall not affect the effectiveness or enforceability of the remaining provisions. The provision that has become entirely or partially ineffective shall be replaced by a new provision, the contents, meaning and purpose of which conform as far as possible economically and legally to those of the ineffective provision.
