

## Proof of advanced knowledge and experience in the field of endovascular therapy

Candidates are required to have completed at least 250 advanced IR procedures (in addition to the 150 vascular EBIR-required procedures, see table below) as primary operator. These advanced procedures may be solely either venous or arterial, or a combination of both. This must be verified by the Authorized Representative as listed in the form.

The corresponding subsections of the European Curriculum and Syllabus for Interventional Radiology, Third Edition, are indicated in brackets after each procedure.

<ul> <li>Venoplasty and/or stenting (central and peripheral) [2.2.1.3.1 to 2.2.1.3.3, 2.2.1.3.6]</li> <li>Venous pharmacomechanical thrombectomy [2.2.1.3.1]</li> <li>IVC filter retrieval [2.2.1.3.2]</li> <li>Venous recanalization of chronic occlusions [2.2.1.3.1, 2.2.1.3.3]</li> <li>Venous embolization (eg. gonadal veins, VM) [2.2.1.1.6, 2.2.1.3.5]</li> <li>Portal and hepatic venous interventions (eg. The required 250 procedures are to be completed since the candidate successfully passed the EBIR, and prior to application submission.
