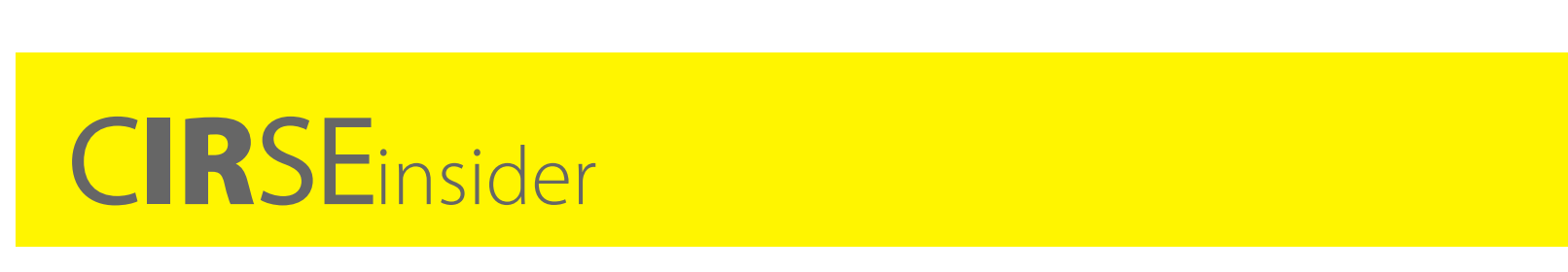


**Reviewer Workshop**


