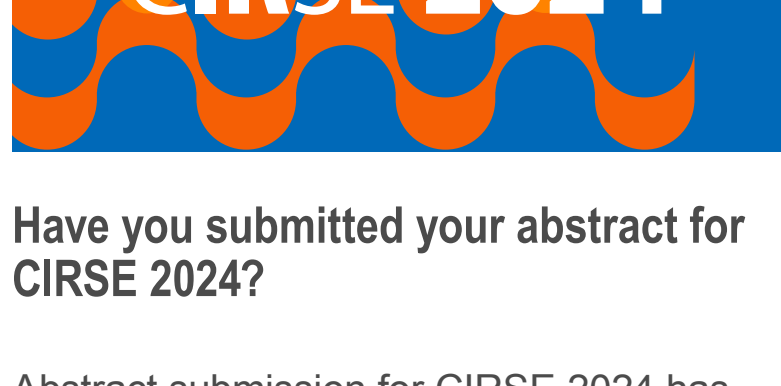




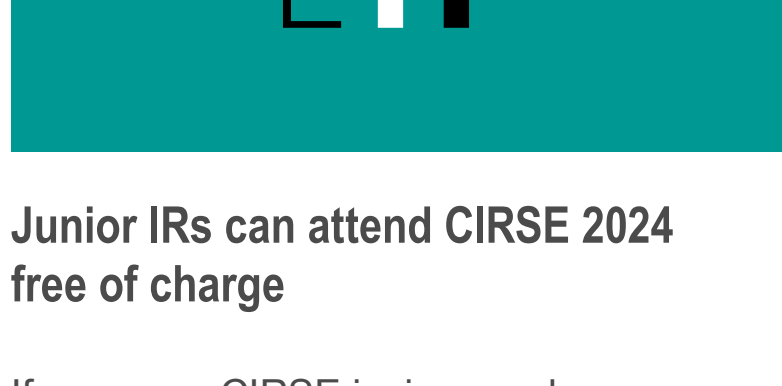
LAST CHANCE TO SUBMIT YOUR ABSTRACT FOR ET 2024

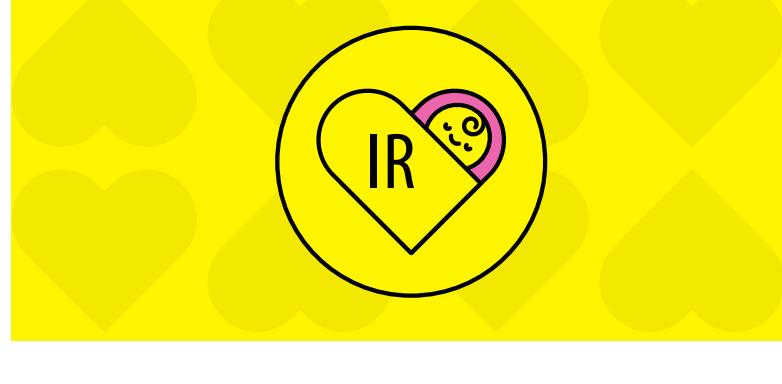
BSIR 2023 now in CIRSE Library

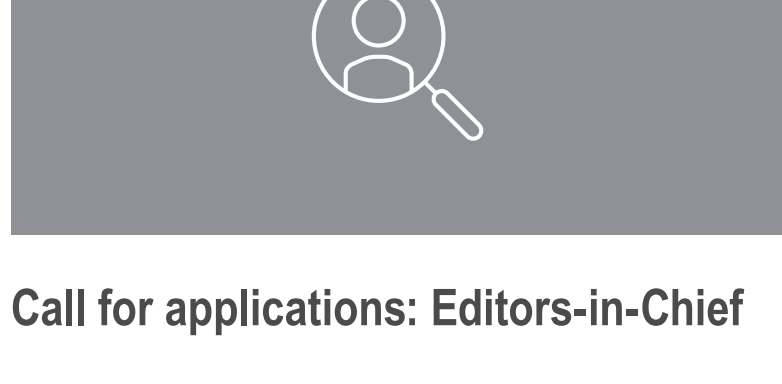
Webinar on paediatric IR coming up

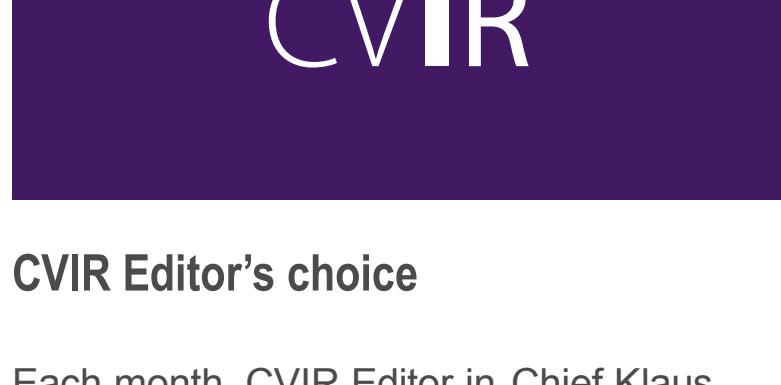
New course on desmoids and other soft tissue tumours

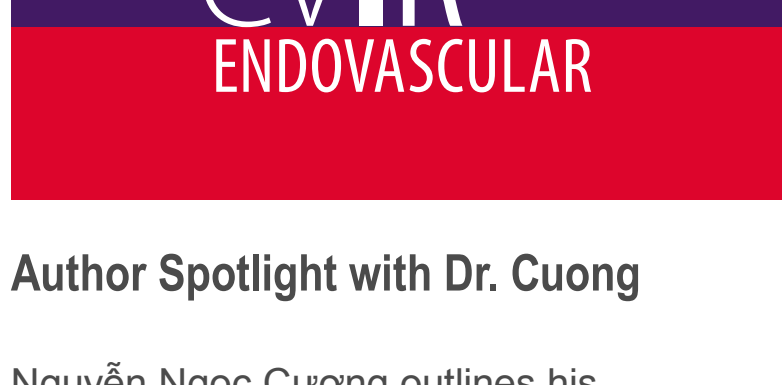
Call for applications: Editors-in-Chief

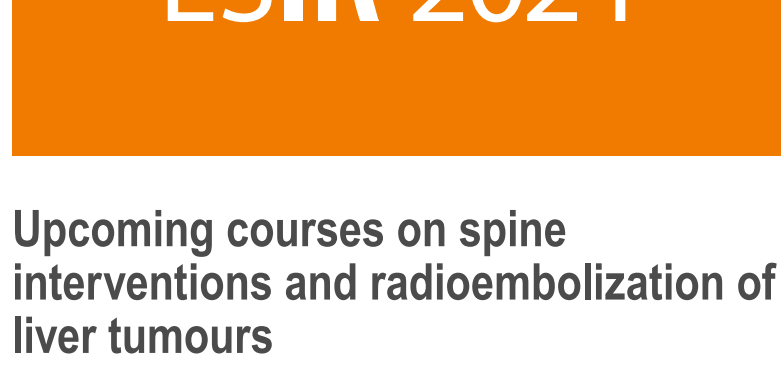

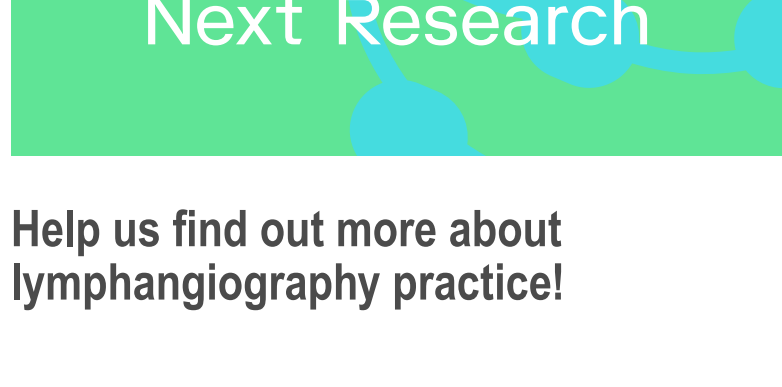
Author Spotlight with Dr. Cuong

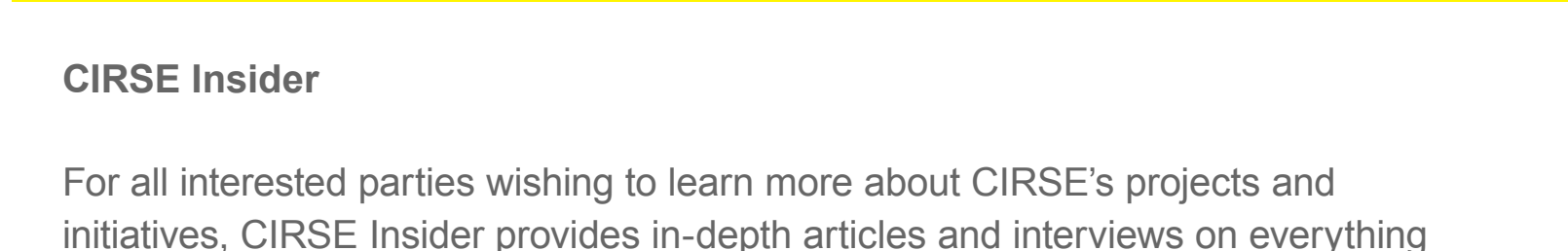
Webinar: First step into IR


