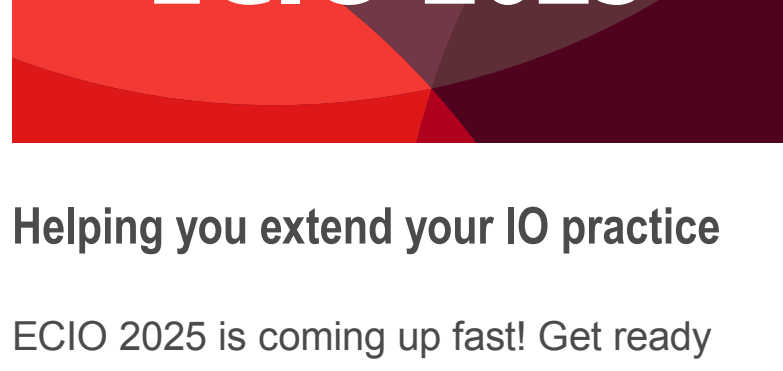




## ABSTRACT SUBMISSION FOR ET 2025 ENDING SOON

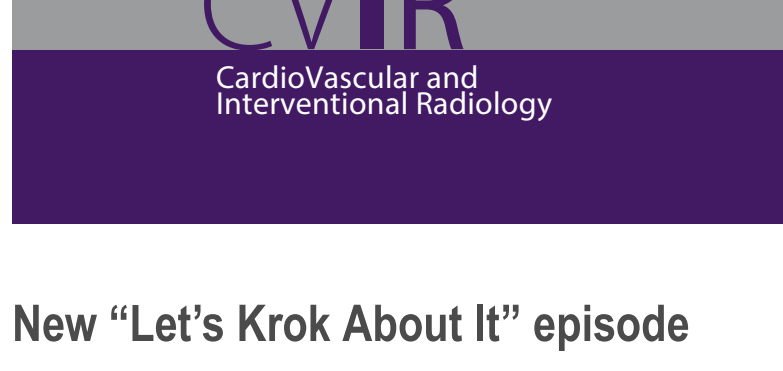
### 40-year anniversary – be part of it!

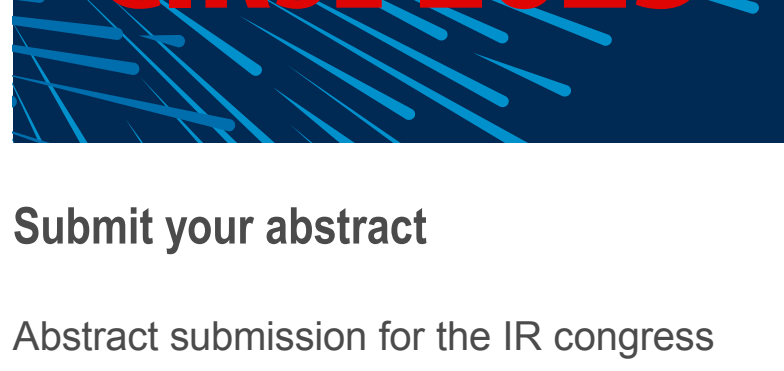
### Course on thermal thyroid ablation

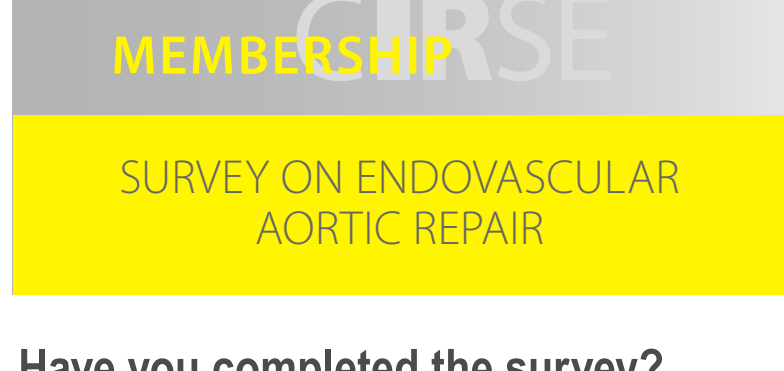

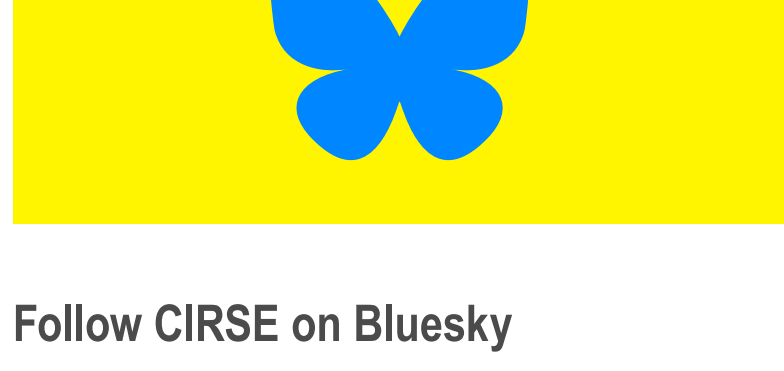
### Have you completed the survey?

### Challenges in paediatric IR

Interventionists continually push the boundaries of medicine, yet paediatric IR faces numerous hurdles that limit its impact. Awareness of its possibilities remains a challenge, as many referring physicians overlook paediatric IR’s potential. Training opportunities are scarce, leaving gaps in expertise. Infrastructure limitations further restrict access. In his blog post for CVIR Endovascular, Dr. Fernando Gomez advocates to push paediatric IR by expanding education and strengthening collaboration to ensure more children receive life-changing care.

### Portovenous interventions of the liver

In April, ESIR will host a two-day course on portovenous interventions of the liver, covering interventions such as TIPS and portal vein embolization. Covering the basic chapters on portal and hepatic venous interventions in the European Curriculum and Syllabus for Interventional Radiology, this course is aimed at giving participants new to this area basic knowledge in the field.
