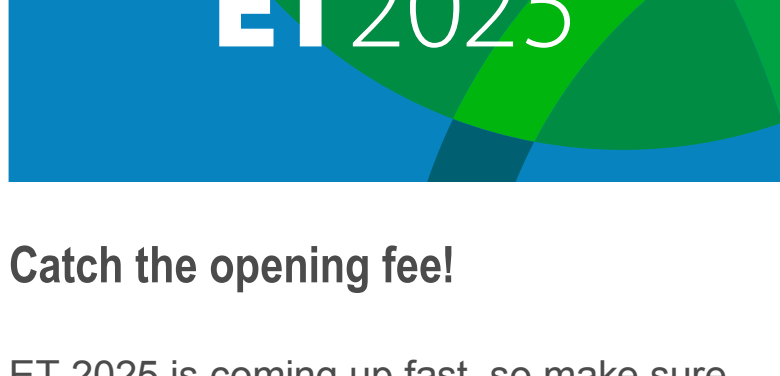
Register for ECIO 2025

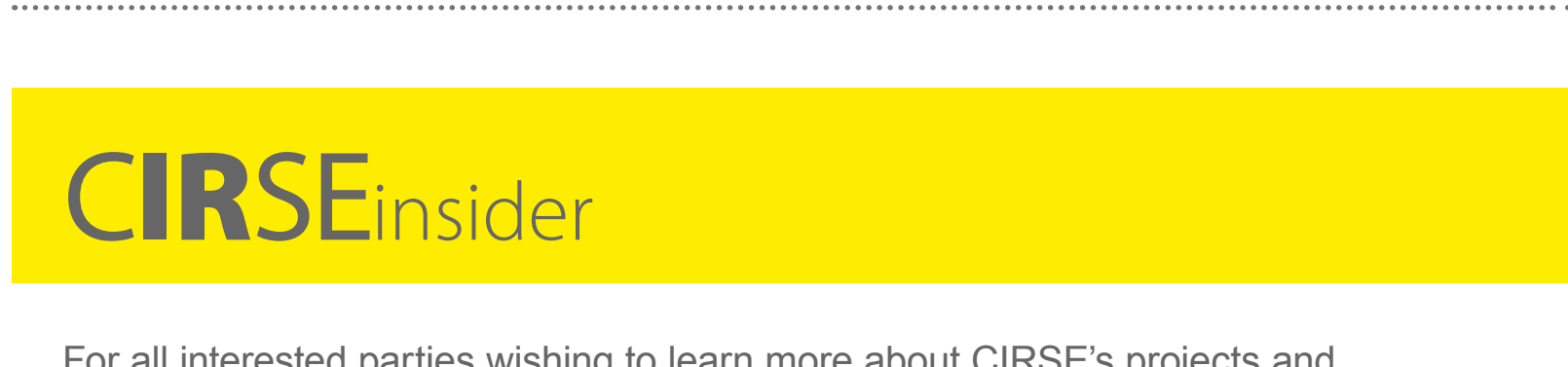
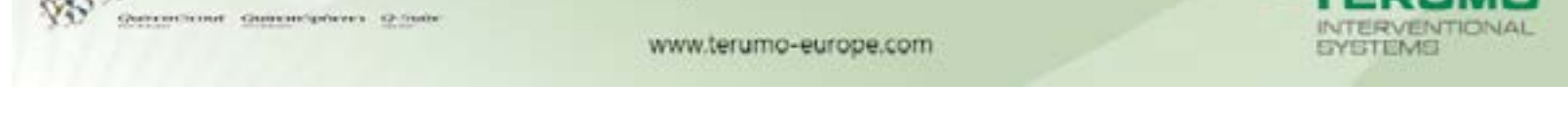
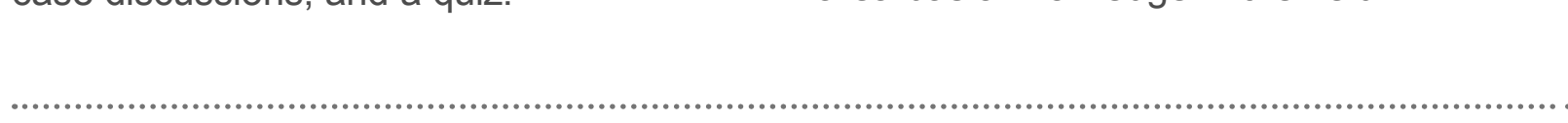
Course on thermal thyroid ablation – Last chance!

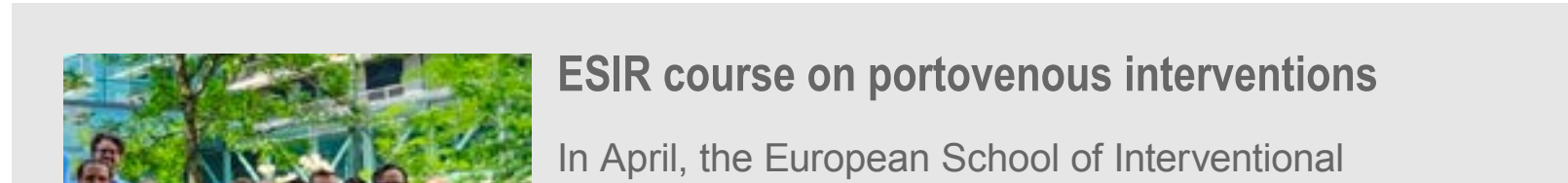



Portovenous interventions of the liver
