



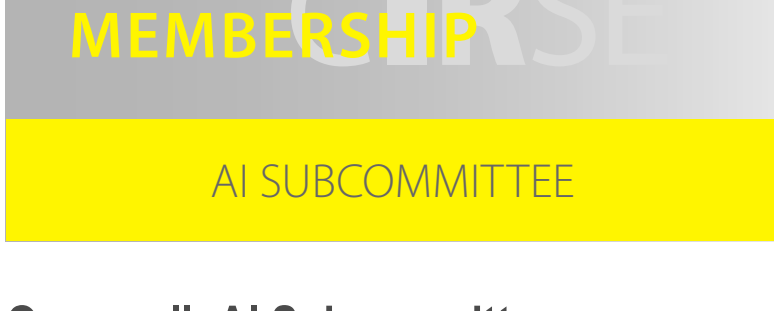
JOIN ET 2025 ONLINE

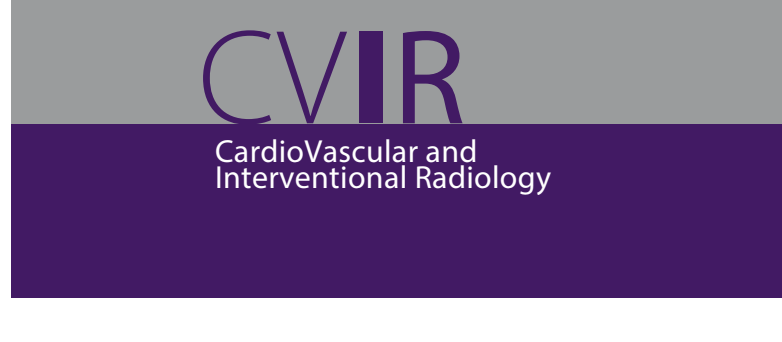
Fit for ET with every SOP

Exploring both intravenous and intra-arterial administration routes, the case underscores the potential for targeted radiopharmaceutical therapy to deliver localized radiation even in challenging settings.


