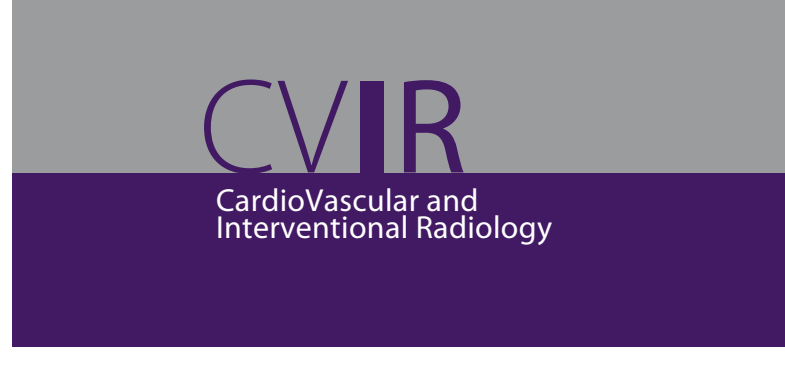
### Courses this fall

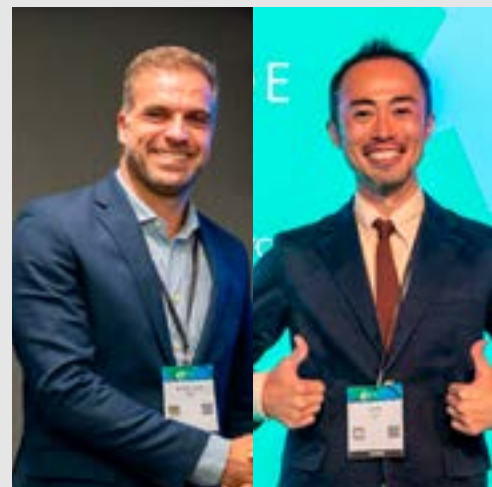
