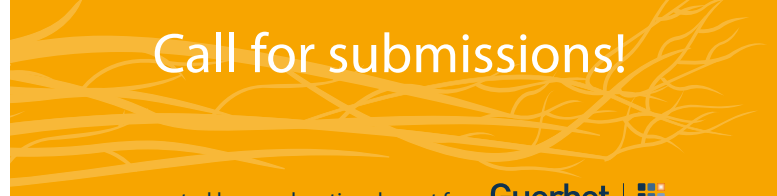




EVEN MORE TO DISCOVER AT CIRSE 2025

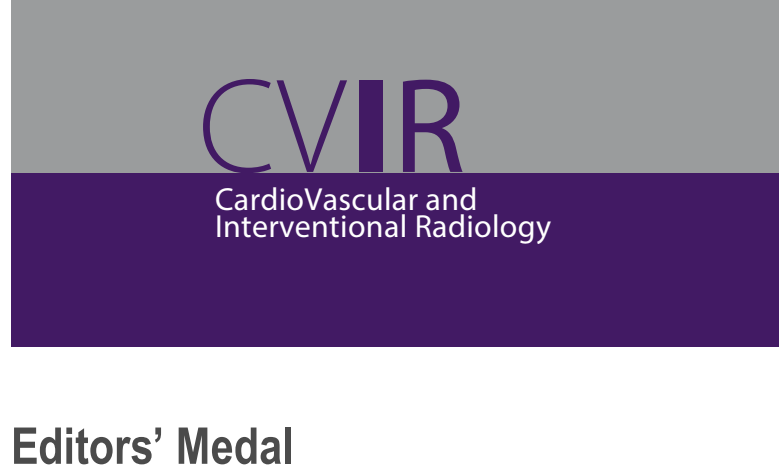
AI workshop at CIRSE 2025

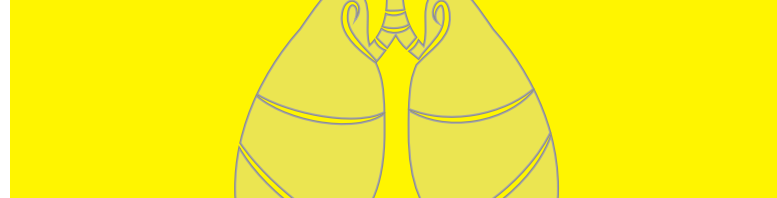
New author spotlight

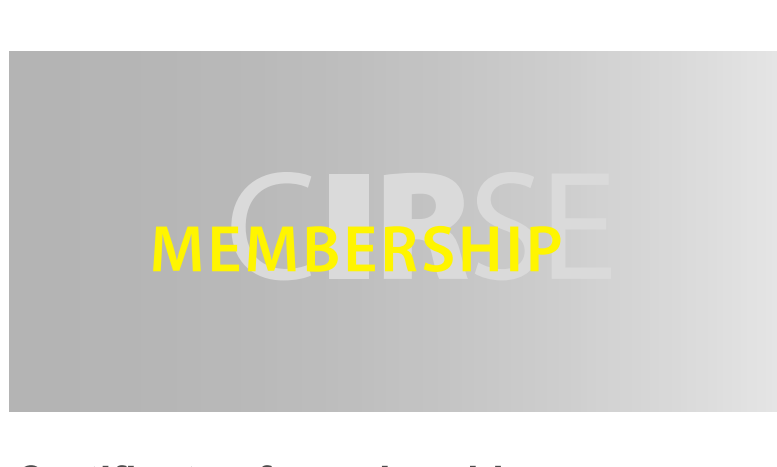
Increasing the visibility of IO in lung cancer treatment
