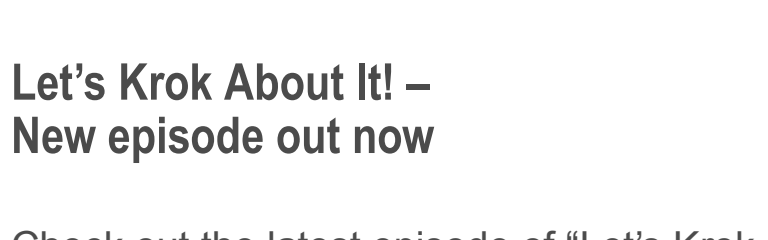
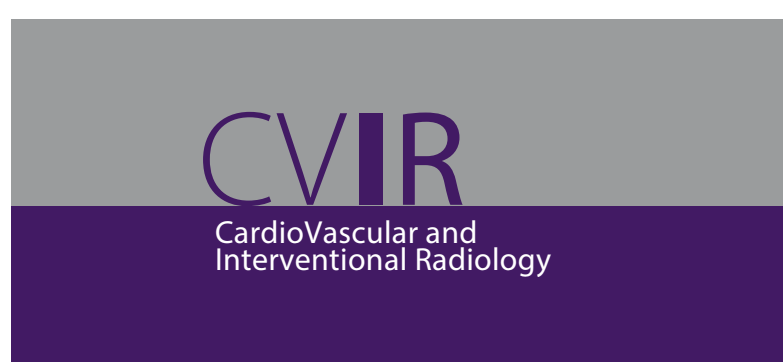
CIRSE launches three new studies

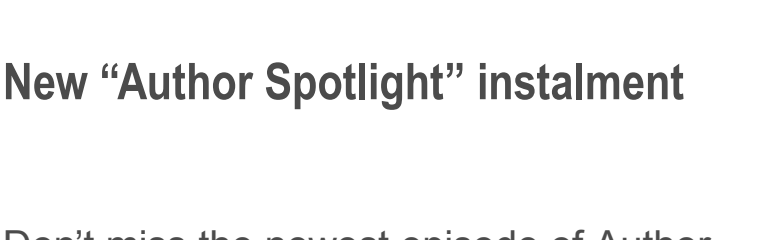
EBIR-IO

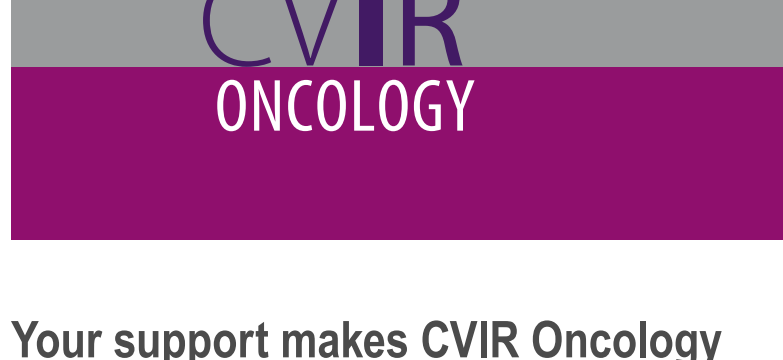
Let’s Krok About It! – New episode out now

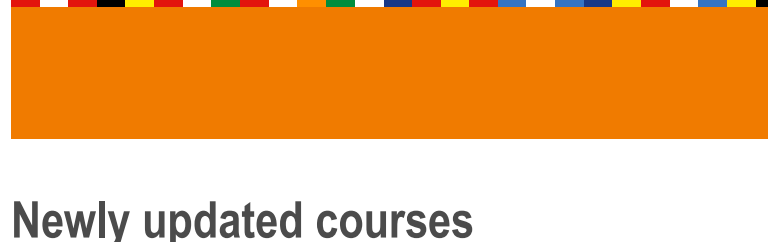

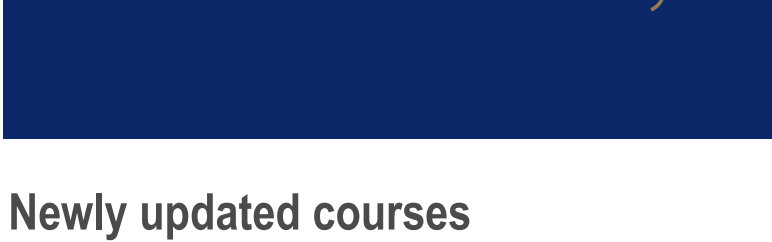

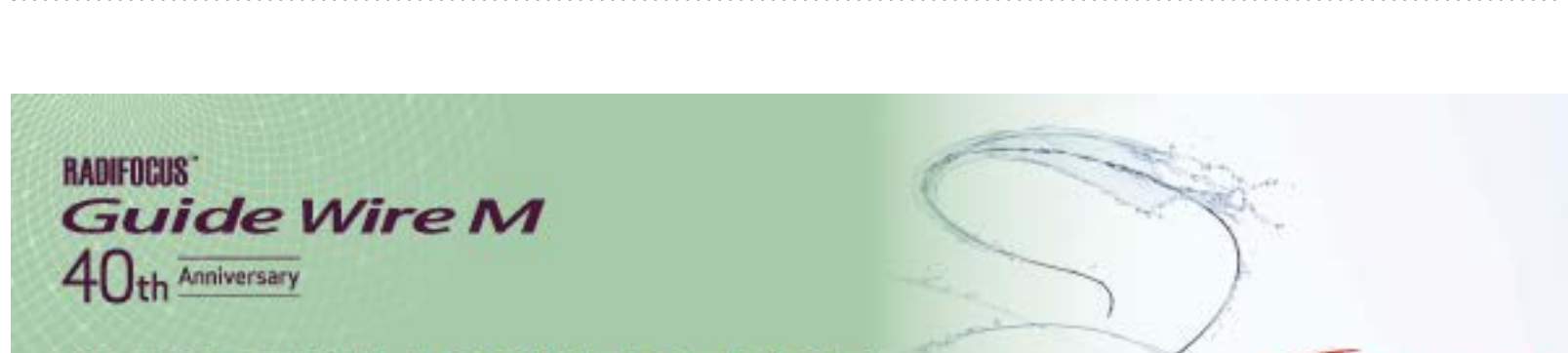
Newly updated courses
