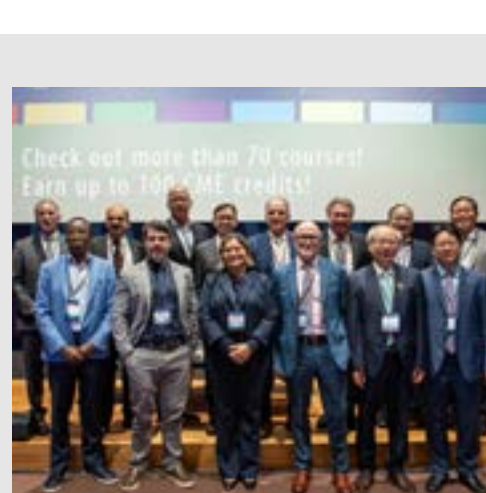
The story behind the study: an interview with the CIRSE 2025 Best Scientific Paper Award winner
