## Dear corporate partners,

However, with this development comes the need to increase both the number of Interventional Radiologists (IRs) and the availability of IR services in hospitals. One of CIRSE's top priorities for the coming years will therefore be to further establish and advance IR, ensuring improved patient access to the treatments it offers.

As the primary representative of IR in Europe and a strong advocate for IR globally, CIRSE is committed to maintaining its leadership of the IR community, remaining at the forefront of knowledge, technology and innovation. With this in mind, the CIRSE leadership introduced its Vision for IR in 2024:

### Focus on Clinical Services and Patient Care

IRs should strive to be actively involved in patient management and care, including participation in multidisciplinary team (MDT) decision-making.

They should have access to the resources and infrastructure required to provide the highest quality clinical services to their patients. Workforce planning should also take into account the specific requirements of IR practice, in addition to diagnostic imaging.

### Focus on Therapies and Treatment

IRs should aim to concentrate primarily on IR. Their involvement in diagnostic imaging should be centred on IR patients and consultations during MDTs. Purely diagnostic imaging services that are independent of IR practice should be minimised.

# Terms and Conditions for Corporate Membership

## Eligibility Criteria

CIRSE Corporate Members are corporations or other organisations, including commercial enterprises, regardless of where they are incorporated or where their headquarters are located, who are interested in the activities and objectives of the Society.

## General Assembly

Corporate Members shall nominate one representative who will act as contact person for all membership related correspondence and who may participate in the General Assembly. Corporate Members shall neither have the right to vote nor to hold office.

## Corporate membership fees

The annual system is based on the calendar year, therefore members are subject to the membership fees as determined in accordance with Article 20.2 of CIRSE's Articles of Association.

## Cancellation or termination

In accordance with Article 7.2, in order to resign from Corporate Membership, the Corporate Member shall send a written notification at least six months before the end of the calendar year.
