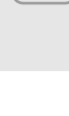
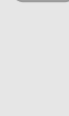
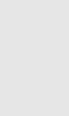
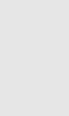




Watch the first European Conference on image-guided pain management on demand

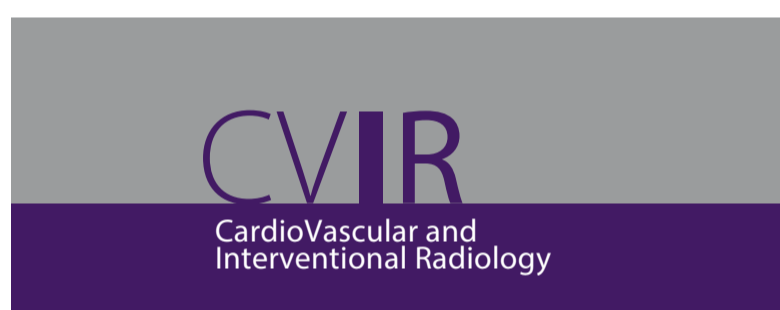
5-year anniversary enrolment offer

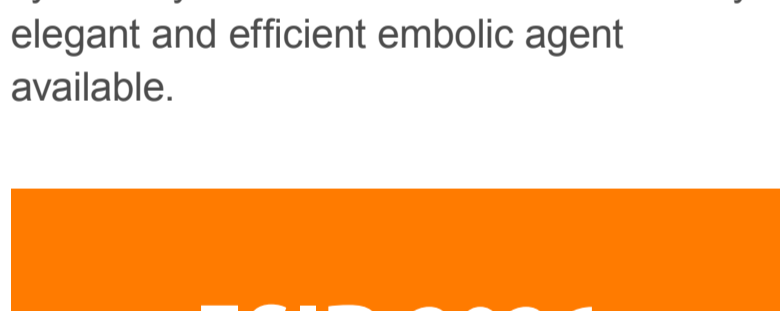
Editor's pick

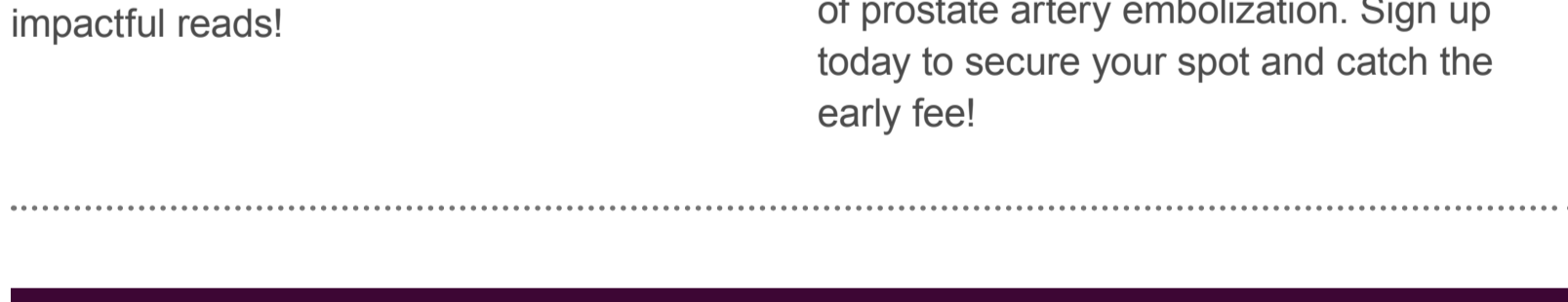
